In honor of Jessica Meredith Jacobsen's memory, the Knights Of Columbus Council # 4011 (Father O'Neill Council) has organized the first annual Jessica Meredith Jacobsen 5K Memorial Run on September 12, 2009. In addition to memorializing Jessica, an avid runner whose spirit and charitable works inspire us, the 5K Run will support the House of Ruth, ICS Tuition Assistance Fund and Father O'Neill Charities. The race will start and end at Immaculate Conception Church in Towson, MD. **Walkers are welcome to participate.** However, no bikes, rollerblades, etc. will be permitted. Walkers please line up in the back.

**Date and Time: 9/12/2009, 8:00 AM**

**Pickup Race Packet September 10th and 11th at Falls Road Running Center, 6247 Falls Rd., Balto., MD**

**Parking:** Park at lower lots of Immaculate Conception Church/School or at the adjacent parking garage.

**Location:** Immaculate Conception Church is located at 200 Ware Avenue in Towson, Maryland, and is near the intersection of York Rd. & Washington Ave.

**The Course:** The race will start and end at Immaculate Conception Church in Towson, MD. After departing Immaculate Conception Church, runners will proceed in a circular route through West Towson.

### Awards

Cash awards of \$100, \$50 and \$25 (and medals) will be given to the top three male and female finishers, and medals will be given to the male and female of each age group, as well as, the best overall Knight and Lady Knight. The age groups are < 18, 18 – 29, 30 – 39, 40 – 49, 50 – 59, 60 – 69, and 70+.

### **Jessica Meredith Jacobsen**

Jessica Meredith Jacobsen died tragically on September 12<sup>th</sup>, 2007. Jessica, a graduate of Villanova University, was a group manager in the marketing and investment services department with T. Rowe Price where she managed a staff of one hundred employees. Jessica was an avid runner and she enjoyed watching her sons play soccer, basketball, and tennis. Jessica volunteered with her neighborhood association and with Immaculate Conception School. In the words of Grand Knight Andrew Gleeson (KoC 4011) "Jessica was one of those rare people, who in a world that seems to move at a million miles an hour, had the ability to stop and give you her direct and genuine attention. She had a thousand watt smile and touched many with her joy and kindness."

Jessica strongly supported Catholic education and the moral values being instilled in her children at Immaculate Conception School. This race will help keep her memory alive and will benefit the community activities which Jessica supported during her life.
